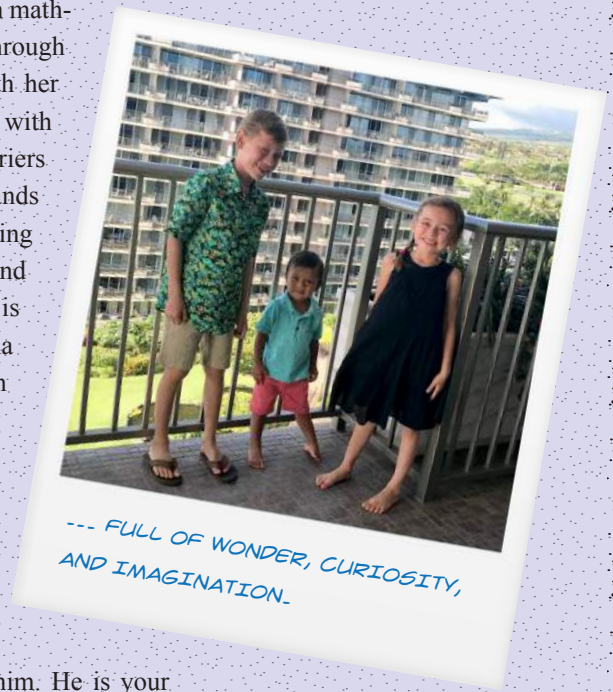
About Evan
